- Negotiating and executing contracts across several organizations, including Union agreements, creative and cast agreements, and licensing agreements.
- Tracking and reporting key performance metrics and industry trends.
- Drafting and managing tour budgets, settlements, and profit/loss statements.
- Preparing key financial and performance reports for producing team, partners and licensors.
- Ongoing support services to active tours and Production team, as needed.

**Required Qualifications:**

- A bachelors or advanced degree (major in Theater, Performing Arts, or related degree).
- At least 3+ years live theater experience. Directing, Production Management, GM, and/or Stage Management experience helpful.
- Experience with the creative and financial development of theatrical productions.
- Extremely organized and able to manage multiple priorities applying project management work methods, working autonomously in a fast-paced entrepreneurial environment.
