Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Participate in and direct/supervise local audio and video crew during load-in and load-out
- Work with local A1 to ensure house system is properly tuned prior to artist arrival
- Lead sound check with Artists, in conjunction with the Stage Manager
- Execute audio and video cues for each performance
- Mix audio for each performance
- Participate in pre-production, production, and advance calls as necessary
- Build cues in QLab from provided materials
- Assist other departments when necessary or available

Required Qualifications:

- Must be experienced mixing on a wide range of consoles (Yamaha, Midas, Allen & Heath, digital/analog, etc)
- Must be proficient with various wireless microphone systems and coordinating RF
- Must be proficient with MacBook Pro laptops
- Must be proficient with QLab 3 or 4
- Touring experience is a must, at least 2 years preferably
- Must have experience working in Union houses, under Union rules
- Ability to work in a fast paced environment
- Must be self-motivated and have strong leadership skills
- Must be able to solve problems as and when they may arise
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills with an outgoing, positive dynamic personality to engage partners and team members
- Must be willing to submit to a background check
- Able to work varied hours and commit 100% of time for regional travel and work on the road for the entire tour
- Ability to lift and carry up to 75 lbs.
